Team Winter Walk Saturday 29th January 2022

Sadly our planned Team Winter walk has had to be changed this year because the walk we'd planned is so muddy that has become a severe slip hazard. Due to that fact that we feel anywhere without graded paths is liable to be the same we have decided that our Team Winter walk will be a re-run of our autumn walk around Horton Country Park, Ewell. Situated only 4 miles from Tolworth, the park has wide paths, some of which were a railway in the past, which can be muddy in places, a Bat Roost, and is a joy to stroll around. The 3.3 mile loop is virtually flat and very child friendly. Directions to the start car park are at the bottom of this article. We'll meet at 10.00 and as ever if the weather is bad we won't walk. If you want to check if the walk is on then please phone Dave on 07540702400.

Please feel free to bring your own hot drink and snack for when we have a pause part way around the loop.

Directions

From Tolworth take the A240 towards Epsom. Turn right into Ruxley Lane, signpost West Ewell B2200. At the traffic lights at the end of Ruxley Lane turn left into Chessington Rd B284. At the roundabout follow the B284, second exit, into Hook Road, with the Horton Park golf Club on your right. At the next roundabout take the second exit, Horton Lane, signpost West Park & New Cottage Hospital. Follow the signs for West Park & New Cottage Hospital for the next 3 roundabouts. 150 yards after the third roundabout take the right-hand turn into Horton Country Park and bear left to the parking area.

If you are coming to the walk please consider sharing your car with others. You can phone or email Dave on dave.farris@talk21.com if you want a lift or can offer others a lift.

To get to the start by public transport take the 418 bus from Tolworth towards Epsom and get off at Longmead Rd / Roy Richmond Way. Cross Longmead Rd to the bus stop on the other side and take the E9 bus, getting off at Ripley Way. Walk back from the bus stop to Horton Lane. Turn left, cross the road and then enter Horton Country Park. From Tolworth Station bus stop this journey is appx 1 hour.
