THiS team summer walk and picnic - Saturday 6th August, Bushy Park

Hi all

Here are the details for the Summer THiS team walk and picnic , Bushy Park, near Hampton Court.

Saturday 6th August 2022 - START TIME 11:00

PLEASE NOTE THE START TIME DIFFERS FROM USUAL DUE TO A WEEKLY ORGAINSED 5K RUN THAT ENDS AROUND 10.00.

This year's summer team walk and picnic will be held in Bushy Park, Hampton. We'll meet by the coffee kiosk in the main car park, to the East of the Diana Fountain and from there take a 3 mile stroll around this wonderful park. If you'd like to come along and simply sit and enjoy the spectacle of the park whilst the rest of us walk then there's toilets nearby, a children's playground and the coffee kiosk..

PLEASE NOTE

We will meet at no earlier than 10.30. This is because the car park is congested before that due to a regular morning Park Run. We'll aim to start our walk at 11.00 with our picnic afterwards, should you wish to stay for that.

The walk will be on paths so there is no need for hiking boots etc. unless you feel more comfortable in them.

We'll be walking around the Western side of the park and propose to stop at the Pheasantry cafe after about an hour of walking, for a drink - tea coffee, or please bring your own if you prefer. We'll be sitting in their picnic area where dogs are allowed as they aren't permitted within the café itself.

All dogs must be kept on a lead at all times because of the the deer roaming free.

After the walk we'll gather for a picnic near the car park hopefully in the shade of a tree.

Do bring your chairs, rugs and your picnic or buy something from the kiosk (limited offering), and of course your sun cream (we hope).

Directions to the start are as follows

Join the A308 Hampton Court Rd from either Hampton Court Bridge or Kingston Bridge, whichever suits your travel. Turn into Bushy Park at the Hampton Court Gate (turn left if coming from Hampton Court or turn right if from Kingston). Drive along Chestnut Avenue to the Diana Fountain and drive around the lake taking the right hand lane as if you were returning to the Hampton Gate, then take a left into the car park as signposted. We'll meet to the East of the kiosk in a shady spot under a tree.
