### **Host Urgently Needed for Ukrainian Refugee Family**

A Ukrainian refugee mother and daughter (aged 6) have arrived in Kingston to find that their expected host can no longer take them. They urgently need a local host to provide a room under the government Homes for Ukraine scheme. One room with either a double or two single beds. The mother speaks English. Please contact Linda Davis (member of Chessington Methodist Church) 07787339243 who is already hosting the girl's grandmother.

Also, if anyone has a spare heated airer they could donate to a Ukrainian family - please let Helen know.

Foodbank – For the first time ever, food banks are giving out more food than is being donated.

Kingston Foodbank say this is an emergency and these items are needed urgently please. Tinned Meat, Long Life Milk, Coffee, Rice, Pasta Sauce, Squash, Instant Mash, Tinned Vegetables Pot Noodles, Oils, Ketchup and Mayonnaise, Sanitary Towels, Toilet Paper, Washing Up Liquid Household Cleaning Products, Washing Machine Tablets, Shaving Foam, Men's Deodorant, 2 in 15 hampoo and Conditioner.
