We are a Church of England Primary School at the heart of the local community. The school does not stop at our school gates but extends out into the local area and we welcome the whole community into our school.

As a Church School, the Governors and staff aim to embed our Christian distinctiveness into all aspects of school life. We do this in many ways but most obviously by promoting our School Vision. This is taken directly from the words of Jesus in the Bible – John 10.10. Jesus tells his disciples that he has come that all people 'might have life and have it to the full'. Inspired by this, our Vision is 'to enable our whole school community to live life in all its fullness'. We think about what this means within all our curriculum areas and our school improvement priorities.

We have strong links with St Matthew's Church and with the Southwark Diocesan Board of Education.

Our school provides the opportunity to experience what it is to be part of a community which celebrates and explores the Christian faith.

It is a place of welcome and hospitality, encouragement and comfort, trust and understanding. We believe that school life at St Matthew's can offer a significant and lasting experience of what it means to have a living relationship with Jesus Christ.



We aim to live out our Christian values throughout the school; by reference to the teaching of the Bible, by nurturing a sense of awe and wonder in the whole of creation and by fostering an accepting and loving community.

Prayer is an important part of school life and the school is supported in prayer through the church, governors, parents, children and others. Children from across the school worked together to write a school prayer and all children are encouraged to learn it off by heart and to use it both in school and at home.
